For example: if a Ballot is called and 50 votes are cast by Members – excluding the Church Member theretichurch is entitled to 25 votes (one half of the votes cast). Thereso are then added together 50+25=75 and the result decided by majority. The effect of this is that no Special Resolution can be passed without the Church voting in favour. In addition, under the current Cl 45 all business other than the election of directors and the appointment of auditors is considered Special Business requiring the same super majorivote (or "Super Vote")

The Anglican Diocese of Sydney considers that this clause is important to preserve the Arligan ethos of the School.

The Diocese has advised that it is open to supporting the removal of this clause on the provisoath a number of clauses in this Constitution are "Preserved".
